Note #1: Pilots may qualify for more than one rating--example, a check pilot may also be rated as a mission pilot. All check pilots may serve as Instructor Pilots.

Note#2: CD Mission rated pilots -- This list is provided periodically by NYW/CDO from NHQ data. A given pilot must be listed therein to validate the CD mission pilot specialty.

Note#3: The ## 60 flag day alert will provide lead time for required actions to maintain currency per stated requirements--the ## flag will remain until the required action, or actions, are taken.

Note #4 All Cadet Orientation Pilots -- both CAP and AFROTC categories -- must be specifically named in an authorization issued by the Wing Commander or his/her designee.

Note 5: Safety Down Day Requirements -- All NYW CAP pilot must complete the mandated training within the specified time frame to validate their CAP Pilot status. NYW CAP pilots not completing the SDD training requirement within the specified time frame, as well as all NYW CAP pilots successfully completing an INITIAL CAPF 5 flight check after the SDD, must complete the review in total (video disk and related texts prepared by DO) to qualify for CAP flight activity as PIC. When a "new SDD" occurs, the "date clock" for all NYW CAP pilots is reset and a new time frame for compliance is established.

Note#6: Responsibility for record acquisition and maintenance rest with the unit (Group) level per CAPR60-1 The required data submission to support this wing-wide "management overview" report maybe submitted in any form that meets all reporting needs. The use of the on-line e-mail form is suggested for both completeness and minimum delay.
